DEATH OF MRS S C BENNETT

On Tuesday evening, Oct 17th, Mrs. Cora Miles Bennett died at he home of her parents, Rev and Mrs. Leonard Miles, after an illness of about two weeks.

Mrs. Bennett was 25 years of age at the time of her death and had with the exception of a short period, always resided in Baxley. She was a quite, unassuming Christian lady who numbered her friends by her acquaintance. She had been a consistent member of the Methodist Church where she always took an active part in its work. She was married to Prof S C Bennett a little over a year ago.

Rev H T Freeman assisted by Revs G N Smith, W J Ballew and R P Fain conducted the funeral services. The remains were carried to Deen Cemetery Wednesday morning and there laid to rest.
