BYROM

Atlanta, Dec 31 - John S Byrom, founder of the town of Byromville, and one of the wealthiest and best known men in south Georgia, died today in a private sanitarium here of paralysis at the age of 62. He had been under treatment here for about three weeks. Mr. Byrom was head of the Byromville National Bank, a big land corporation, had large mercantile interests, a sawmill and other enterprises.

He leaves two sons, W.H. and S.B. Byrom, who are interested in the varied interests of the firm. Mrs. Brown Wimberly, of Macon, is a sister of the deceased. The funeral will take place Wednesday in Byromville.
